The Mediterranea Trio was founded in 2007 while Italian pianist Elenlucia, Greek violinist Markella and Italian cellist Alessandro were studying at the Royal College of Music. Prompted by their love for chamber music and as a tribute to their Mediterranean origins, they named the trio Mediterranea. A very promising young chamber group bursting with emotion and personality, the Mediterranea Trio explores a wide-ranging repertoire and seeks inspiration in every aspect of life.

After its debut at the National Gallery, the Mediterranea Trio went on to perform at venues such as St Martin-in-the-Fields, St James's Piccadilly, Regent Hall, the Lansdowne Club in Mayfair, the Royal College of Music, Cheltenham Town Hall and Rothamsted Manor in Harpenden. It also took part in the Chilingirian Chamberfest in February 2009.

Future engagements include an evening concert at the Louth Concert Society, performances during the Chilingirian Chamber Music Festival 2010, the Bedford Park Festival, St Anne's Lutheran Church in London, the National Gallery, St Mary's in Aylesbury, St Barnabas in Ealing, the Foundling Museum, as well as two evening concerts at Villa Malfitano in Palermo.
